POLICY 8.17 FIREMED MEMBERSHIP

PURPOSE:

To establish the guidelines for providing members of Jefferson Rural Fire Protection District free membership to FireMed.

PROCEDURES:

A. The Fire District will provide a FireMed membership to the following.

- 1. A person who is a member of the Jefferson Volunteer Firefighter Association.
- 2. A person who retires from the District in good standing as a volunteer or employee after 10 or more years of service, or has reached the age of 65 with at least 5 years of service.
- 3. A person who sustained a life-long disabling injury that prevents continued ability to work, when the injury was caused during official activities or duties performed in conjunction with the Jefferson Rural Fire Protection District as a volunteer or employee.
- 4. A person who is employed full-time or part-time by Jefferson Rural Fire Protection District.
- 5. A person must live in the boundaries of the Fire District's Ambulance Service Area or the area of Lebanon Fire District ASA served by the Jefferson Fire District.
- B. FireMed membership will be granted and/or renewed July 1 of each year.
