PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for the use of the Lock Box entry system.

PROCEDURE

A. Establish the need for entry

- 1. Emergency
- 2. Nonemergency
- 3. Forced entry vs. Lock Box key entry

B. Locate the Lock Box

- 1. Pre-fire plan
- 2. Generally located near the main entrance

C. Operational guidelines

- 1. Only fire department personnel will have the master key to the Lock Box system
- 2. If possible, notify responsible party of fire department use of Lock Box to gain entry.
- 3. If possible, do not leave Lock Box key unattended in lock during fire department operations. It may be necessary to leave a firefighter at a keyed gate to keep open to allow other apparatus access.

KEY CONSIDERATIONS

- Consider other means of entry if Lock Box system unsafe
- Keyed gates may automatically close when the key is removed
