APPARATUS RESTORATION

- A. It is the responsibility of the apparatus operator to make sure all equipment is returned to the apparatus and accounted for.
- B. Tools and equipment should be cleaned as well as possible at the scene with a final cleansing at the station.
- C. Hose used should be rolled prior to placing it back onto the apparatus.
 - 1. To limit the need to carry hose, the apparatus should be brought to the location of the hose whenever possible.
 - 2. Fire apparatus should not back up to retrieve hose. This is a dangerous and unnecessary action.
- D. Personnel restoring apparatus may do so without wearing their coats or helmets. If equipment must be retrieved from a hazardous area full protective gear will be worn.
- E. After returning to the station all personnel are responsible for cleaning and restoring the apparatus. If you must be released early, the unit Officer must grant permission.
- F. Personnel who did not respond on the call and can assist with restoration are encouraged to so.
- G. All S.C.B.A.'s will be cleaned following the protocol provided by the manufacturer.
